Jingle Bell Napkin Rings

- ~ Supplies ~
 - <u>1/2" Silver Jingle Bells 144/pk</u> I used 28 bells per napkin ring.
 - florist wire cut in approx. 6" lengths
 - silver 1/8" wired ribbon cut in approx. 6" pieces
 - scissors
 - <u>needle nose pliers</u>

~ Directions ~

- 1. Cut the florist wire in a 6" length and created a loop at one end so that the bells will not fall off as you string them onto the wire.
- 2. Add the 28 bells to the wire
- 3. Push the bells close together
- 4. Take the end of the wire and put it through the loop on the other end, be sure the bells are strung tight together and tightly twist the ends of the wire together. Cut off any excess wire and tuck inside the bells. Tie the wired ribbon in a bow around the napkin ring.
- 5. Slide the napkin ring over desired cloth napkin
