DIY Spooky Terrarium

Black Garbage bag

Twigs - I used ones from my yard

Toy [Hairy Spider](#)

~ Directions ~

1. Vase/ Terrarium: Clean the vase or terrarium
2. Black Garbage Bag: Cut off the top of the garbage bag(So it is not so big and bulky) and fill it with packing peanuts. Tie it closed and place in the bottom of the vase. You want it to be uneven and “hilly”
3. [Reindeer Moss](#): Cover the peanut filled garbage bag completely with the moss, make sure to get down the sides so none of the bag is showing.
4. [Vase Filler Stones](#): Place a few stones around the moss and the edges
5. [Spanish Moss](#): lightly spread the stringy spanish moss
6. Twigs: I found some twigs in my yard and stuck them to the outer edges of the glass and into the moss to secure.
7. [Spider Web](#): Stretch a few pieces of the spider web around the twigs.
8. [Hairy Spider](#): add a spider for the final touch
